

## IZZY DOLL

DK wool. 3.5mm (10) needles

- Work in stocking stitch throughout
- Cast on 32 Sts
- Work four rows for feet – change yarn
- Work 14 rows for skirt / trousers – change yarn
- Work 12 rows for sweater – change yarn
- Work 8 rows for face – change yarn
- Work 11 rows for hat as follows:
  - Rows 1 – 4 stocking stitch
  - Row 5 [k4, k2tog, k5, k2tog] x2, k4,k2tog
  - Row 6 and all alternate rows purl
  - Row 7 [k3, k2tog, k4, k2tog] x2, k3,k2tog
  - Row 9 [k2, k2tog, k3, k2tog] x2, k2,k2tog (17sts)
  - Row 11 [k2tog, k1] x 5, k2tog (11sts)
  - Draw yarn through remaining stitches and pull up and fasten off.

### **To Finish:**

- Sew sides together to form a centre back seam
- Stuff head. Weave a strand of matching yarn across the first face row.
- Draw up to form neck and secure ends.
- Repeat for body, drawing in at the ankles – Stuff.
- Stuff feet and sew up bottom.
- With matching yarn, form arms with tiny backstitches through all layers from waist to 5 rows beneath the neck.
- Define the legs in same way from bottom to a little below the waistline.
- Embroider hair and facial features as desired.
