

Proposed Church Union: Bennachie Parish Churches

Our Kirk Session, along with the Sessions of Kemnay, Blairdaff/Chapel of Garioch, Cluny, Monymusk and Echt/Midmar, have approved a Basis of Union to move our six congregations into a single parish with a team ministry. This is part of a series of weekly notes to inform our congregations about the proposed union. By the end of April each Congregation will be invited to vote on the proposed union at a congregational meeting.

By now, if you are a member, you will have received a booklet outlining the proposed Union which includes a draft of the Basis of Union document. If you have not received this information and would like a copy, please contact Neil or Ian (details below).

The Basis of Union and Basis of Team Ministry are working their way through the various legal committees of the church and will be presented to the congregation in their final form (at least 2 weeks) in advance of the Congregational Meeting on the 23rd of April 2023.

Meanwhile we would like to invite you to a public Q & A meeting on Sunday, 2nd April 2023, at 11:00am (directly after the morning service), at which anyone is welcome to raise questions or make comments about the proposed union.
